

OAK TREE PARK POOL RULES

Pool Hours: Tue – Fri 12:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
Sat – Sun 1:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.
Closed Mondays (except Memorial Day & Labor Day)

The facilities are for the benefit of members of Oak Tree Park Association Inc.
Facilities are available for rental (outside of summer pool hours) to association members in good standing.

**All residents and guests swim at their own risk,
No unattended swimming.
Lifeguard decisions are final.**

1. All residents/guests must sign-in.
2. Guests are welcome during regular pool hours; however they remain the sole responsibility of the member. Regular attendance of non-members is not permitted.
3. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at least 17 years of age.
4. Profane language, hazing or other disruptive or destructive behavior will not be tolerated. Violators will be directed to leave the pool by the lifeguards.
5. Running or excessive horseplay is prohibited.
6. No glass is allowed in the pool area. No food or drinks are allowed in the pool.
7. No resident/guest under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be allowed to swim.
8. No person of questionable swimming ability is allowed in the water over their head unless accompanied by a parent/guardian even if a floatation aid is used.
9. All flotation devices are subject to lifeguard approval.
10. No diving in shallow water. Diving in deep-end areas permitted; however no back diving or flips are permitted.
11. No un-hemmed cutoffs are allowed in the water.
12. No person with open wounds, bandages, or any symptom of any communicable disease is allowed in the pool.
13. All babies/toddlers must wear a swim suit and swim diaper which fits snugly around the legs. No regular diapers allowed.
14. Swimmers must shower prior to entering pool (City Health Ordinance).
15. Pool will close immediately in the event of hazardous weather, which includes thunder.
16. All fees associated with rentals i.e. lifeguards, property damage, additional cleaning) are the responsibility of the hosting member when renting facilities.
